## Job Description

- Quality Control Inspector is responsible for checking, verifying, and inspecting products throughout the manufacturing process and prior to shipping to ensure the highest level of satisfaction for our customers.

## Responsibilities

- Perform quality control inspections, checks, and tests during all stages of manufacture;
- Inspect incoming products and material for damage, defects, and compliance with prints;
- Keep record of inspections using inspection reports and other inspection documents per the customers standards;
- Ensure all products meet tolerance and quality standards prior to shipping;
- Promoting, contributing to, and supporting the Quality Management System;
- Communicating with production, estimation, and management personnel over quality concerns or non-conformances;
- Approving in-process production by confirming specifications; conducting visual and measurement tests using appropriate metrology equipment and communicating required adjustments to production supervisor, document all findings;
- Extensive use of metrology equipment;
- Maintaining calibration of all quality equipment;
- Other duties related to our manufacturing and quality process. Duties, responsibilities, and expectations may be changed or modified at any time.

## Requirements

- Background in Quality Inspection, Mechanical Design, or related field;
- Reading and interpreting blueprints;
- Knowledge of using a variety of inspection equipment including tools, gages, surface plates and CMM software;
- Ability to interpret and apply GD&T;
- Verbal and written communication skills;
- Ability to frequently move around and lift up to 40 pounds;
- Strong work ethic, ability to be self-driven in a smaller work environment;
- Knowledge of precision manufacturing operations and knowledge of the systems necessary to maintain a high level of quality machined parts.
