

Manufacturing Estimator

Job Description

At Northwest Tool, a Manufacturing Estimator is responsible for all aspects of quoting parts and projects to customers, including discussing parts and projects with the customer, interpreting blueprints, determining manufacturing process, pricing according to current material and labor rates, and entering data into the ERP system. They are also responsible for assisting other estimators and engineers with data entry. This Estimator is also responsible for communicating with existing and potential customers to help meet their needs.

Job Functions

- Estimating new parts as requested by the customer.
- Repricing repeat parts based on current material and labor rates.
- Reviewing customer purchase orders for accuracy, proper drawings, and pricing information.
- Data entry of routings/processes/part information into ERP System.
- Communicating with customers regarding projects.
- Interacting with potential customers as part of the Northwest Tool Sales Team. Some travel may be required.
- Ensures compliance with industry standards and safety regulations.
- Uses general office equipment, including phones, filing systems, computers, copy machines/fax machines/scanners.
- Maintains a shop floor presence, make decisions, organize, and have problem/resolution skills.
- Other duties as assigned.
